SUMMER CAMP IS OPEN

2025 summer camp runs weekly from thru August 8. Camp begins at 8 am and concludes at 4 pm each day. There will be no camp on July 4th. Camp will be located at Tyl Middle School utilizing the gym, cafeteria, auditorium and outdoor spaces. There will be optional trips for the campers to attend at an additional cost.

The weekly price is \$75.

Children must be 5 years old at the time they begin camp and not older than 12 years. Campers must be Montville residents. We have a limit of 230 campers per week. Some weeks fill up so register early. Camp registration is ongoing from 8 am to 4:30 pm both in person or online.

Bus transportation is provided from and to Mohegan, Murphy, Oakdale and Palmer Schools for those campers needing it. The schedule will be available at registration.
